NOTICE OF RACE



1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2, Off the Beach Boats, shall apply.
- 1.3 Appendix T, Arbitration, and the Equipment Rules of Sailing will apply.
- 1.4 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board and on the Safety Beach Sailing Club website (www.sbsc.net.au).
- 1.5 The *Racing Rules of Sailing* will be altered as follows:
- (a) Rule 41, Outside Help, by adding: "A boat may also receive outside help where the Race Committee deems that the vessel and its crew require assistance in order to right a capsized vessel and/or return its crew to the vessel in order to continue racing."

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the International 14 and B14 classes that are financial members of the Victorian Fourteen Foot Sailing Council or B14 Australian Association respectively.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry and paying the required fee at <https://www.trybooking.com/book/event?eid=351508> by Friday 9th March 2018.

4 FEES

Required fees are as follows:

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.3 No Warning signal will be made after 1500 hrs on Monday 12th March 2018.
- 5.4 The series will comprise of a maximum of seven races.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall hold a valid measurement certificate which Competitors may be required to produce. Measurement checks and inspections may be carried out at any time. A boat selected for inspection shall follow the instructions of the Race Committee.

7 VENUE

Attachment A shows the location of the Safety Beach Sailing Club and the racing areas.

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

For all classes rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10 SCORING

10.1 There are 7 races scheduled of which 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 SUPPORT BOATS

Coaches and support personal will not be permitted in the race area during the conduct of racing.

12 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones and any form of GPS device. [DP]

14 PRIZES

14.1 The class association shall provide the trophies.

14.2 Junior B14 champion for entrants under the age of 21 as at 30 September 2017.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD \$5,000,000 per incident or the equivalent (recommended AUD \$10,000,000). Competitors who enter online or sign the entry form are deemed to have declared they hold such cover. Competitors may be required to produce evidence of such insurance and any competitor not holding such cover shall withdraw their entry.

17 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in an Event, a competitor automatically grants the Organising Authority, the Association and the sponsors of the Event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said Event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said Event without compensation.

18 AMENDMENTS

Any amendments to this Notice of Race shall be posted on the Safety Beach Sailing Club website (www.sbisc.net.au) and the B14 Australian Association website (www.b14.org.au) no later than Friday 23rd February 2018.
